

The History of Bowling Competitions for Andover Bowling Club 1913-2012

Researched and Compiled by M R Corden

The following statistical summary would not have been possible without the efforts of the late **Derek C Spencer** who diligently compiled and maintained handbooks for over 30 years and to whom we all owe our gratitude.

Club Competitions

The first competition to be introduced in **1919** was the **Men's Championship** The cup which is still played for today was presented by the **1919 committee**. The competition has been played every year since without interruption. Most wins have been achieved by Archie Mitchell** who won the competition 7 times (4 consecutive) between 1945 and 1967. The most wins achieved by a current member is 3 by Roy Turner*. For full history refer to **Appendix A**.

Two new competitions were introduced in **1924**, the **Handicap Singles** for which a cup was donated by **Lieutenant Commander R Fletcher MP** and the **Rinks Competition** which was contested for a challenge bowl presented by **W R Ponting** in memory of his wife **Ada**. **W R Ponting** was the local mayor at that time and as such he was president of the club. There is no record of him ever playing bowls.

The **Handicap Singles** has been contested every year since but for some reason the final was not played in 1950. The honours for the most wins is shared by Jack Blake (1946-1961) and Den Morgan (1997-2005) who both won the competition 5 times. In 2002 the competition became mixed when the ladies were allowed to enter following the demise of their own competition. Ann Eaton became the first and only lady winner to date in 2007. Dave Hamilton with 3 wins has had most success from our current membership. The Men's Championship and Handicap Singles competitions have been won by the same member in one year on 10 occasions but George Hacking has the most 'doubles' with 3 in 1978, 1979 and 1982. For full history refer to **Appendix B**.

The **Rinks Competition** was contested between 1924 and 1951 when it was suspended due to the difficulty in arranging for 8 players to accept the same date and be at the green collectively. R Hawthorne, Roly Soper, Vic Bull and R H Soper share the honours by each being on the winning side on 4 occasions. For full history refer to **Appendix J**.

The **Mens Drawn Pairs Competition** started in **1932**, playing for a cup given by **Mr J Eyles**. Surprisingly this competition has been won twice by the same pair A.F (Smudger)Smith and Sid Gilham in 1959 and 1960. Archie Mitchell was on the winning side on 9 occasions but with a different partner each time. This became a mixed competition in 2003. For full history refer to **Appendix R**.

In **1935 H.M.C Drummond Wolf** a local MP donated a cup for the **Men's Club Triples** which started in that year. This was initially a seasonal tournament but sometime around about 1980 it changed to be a one day competition and in 2003 it became a mixed competition. As you would expect by now Archie Mitchell was in the winning side on 8 occasions followed by Cecil Horne with 7 wins and Laurie Marles with 6. It is interesting to note that since the competition has become mixed it has been dominated by the ladies who have had 2 members in the winning triple on 7 of the 10 occasions its has been played. Mike Ford with 3 has most wins from the current members. For full history refer to **Appendix N**.

In **1952** the defunct rinks competition was replaced with a **Singles Two Woods Competition** but still playing for the **Ada Ponting Bowl**. This competition had its teething problems and for some reason the final was not played in 1953 and 1954 but has taken place on all years since. Archie Mitchell again holds the record for the most wins with 6. Ken Eaton with 3 wins is the current member with most victories. In 2003 this competition became mixed when the ladies joined following the demise of their own competition. For full history refer to **Appendix C**.

In 1960 the Club Committee donated a cup and the **Men's Novices Singles Competition** started in **1961**. This competition is open to all club members with less than 5 years bowling experience who have not

won another singles competition, so by definition can only be won by the same person once. This was changed in 2002 when it was amalgamated with the Ladies Competition to create the **Mixed Novices Competition**. For full history refer to **Appendix D**.

Following the founding of Andover Ladies in 1968 the Ladies Competitions started in **1970** with the introduction of the **Ladies Championship** and **Ladies Novices Singles Competitions**. The Ladies Championship is contested for the **Howard Cup** presented by Mrs Bradley and the Novices for a cup presented by the 'famous' **Archie Mitchell**. The **Ladies Championship** has been won most times by Maisie Spinks with 7 wins closely followed by Chris Spencer with 6. Cynthia Hamilton one of our current active members is next with 5. For full history refer to **Appendix E**.

The Ladies Novices Singles was contested from 1970 until 2002 when it merged with the Men's Competition. As with the men's it could only be won once by the same person. For full history refer to **Appendix G**.

Two further Ladies Competitions were introduced in **1972**. The **Ladies Pairs** was played for the **Forrester Challenge Cup** and the **Ladies Two Woods** was played for the **Eason Cup**. Both these competitions lasted for 30 years until they were discontinued and merged with the men's competitions in 2003. In the **Two Woods** Maisie Spinks has the record for most wins with 5. Chris Spencer and Pam West both achieved 4 wins. In 1984 Chris Spencer won all 3 Ladies Singles Competitions and the Ladies Pairs. Sue Milton won all the Ladies Singles competitions in 2002. For full history refer to **Appendix F**.

The **Ladies Pairs** was won most times by Chris Spencer with 7. For full history refer to **Appendix S**.

A **Ladies Handicap** competition commenced in **1979** and the trophy was presented by **Betty Jones and Ciss Clark**. This competition was suspended after 2002 when it merged with the men's competition. The Ladies Championship and Handicap Singles competitions were won by the same member in one year on 6 occasions. Margaret Hunt in 1981, Chris Spencer in 1984, Maisie Spinks in 1988, Cynthia Hamilton in 1999, Ann Eaton in 2001 and Sue Milton in 2002. For full history refer to **Appendix H**.

The first one day tournament was also introduced in **1979**. The trophy was presented by F West the wife of the late **Lennie West** and it is a **Mixed Triples Competition**. Being a drawn competition it is unlikely that the same triple will be drawn together and even more unlikely that the same triple will win the competition on more than one occasion. The bowler with the most winning trophies is Roy Turner with 5. For full history refer to **Appendix M**.

In **1980** the second new one day tournament was introduced. A **Men's Singles Tournament** was played for a trophy donated by **Sid Butler** who was the club president at that time. It was initially a straight knockout over 15 ends but was later changed to its current league format with semi-finals and final. Mike Ford currently has most wins with 5. For full history refer to **Appendix K**.

1984 saw the start of a **Ladies Singles Tournament**, the trophy being donated by Mr and Mrs B C Setchell in memory of **Mrs Bradley**. She had been a member for many years and was the first Ladies President but for reasons best known to her she did not want to reveal her first name and was simply known as '**B**'. The tournament is run on the same basis as the Sid Butler, being a one day tournament. Audrey Todd and Cynthia Hamilton share the honours for most wins to date with 3 each. Unfortunately this competition was not held in 2012 due to lack of numbers and bad weather. For full history refer to **Appendix L**.

A further one day **Mixed Triples** began in **1990** when Pam Keel donated a trophy in memory of her husband **Jack Keel**. This competition is run on the same basis as the Lennie West and once again Roy Turner has been in the winning team most times with 4 victories. For full history refer to **Appendix P**.

In **1992** a one day **Mixed Pairs Two Woods Tournament** was introduced and the trophy was donated by David Hamilton in memory of his father-in-law **George Hacking**. It stayed as a pairs tournament until 1999 after which time it was played as mixed triples but still using two woods. Jack Ewens has recorded most victories winning twice when it was pairs and twice as a triple. Richard Hunt and Ken

Eaton share the honours for the most wins from current members with 3 each, all since 1999. For full history refer to **Appendix Q**.

The **Hamilton Married Pairs Cup** commenced in **1994** when Dave Hamilton presented a shield. Most wins have been recorded by Nora and John Johnston with 4 but there are currently 3 couples with 3 wins each so this record could be equalled or beaten soon. For full history refer to **Appendix T**.

In **2003** after the death of **Derek Spencer** his wife Chris donated a shield which is played for by the **Whitchurch League A, B and C teams**. Each team plays each other in a combination of singles, pairs and triples with points being awarded for each event. The B team have most wins to date with 4. For full history refer to **Appendix Z**.

A **Ladies Invitation Competition** whereby ladies can invite a male partner, but not their husband was introduced in 2003. For full history refer to **Appendix U**.

A **Mixed Pairs** one day competition was introduced in 2010. A trophy that had been donated to Andover by Salisbury Bowling Association in 1988, marking their 75th anniversary, has been used for this competition. For full history refer to **Appendix V**.

Starred bowlers

*Roy along with his brother Billy are currently the clubs longest standing playing members. There were originally 3 Turner brothers who joined on the same day in 1975 but sadly Arthur died in Nov 2012.

**Archie Mitchell a local grocer and ex Andover Cricketer was the best bowler that has played for Andover if records are anything to go by. As well as his hoard of club trophies he also won many open competitions. He was one of the captains of the successful Andover side which won the Salisbury and District League for 5 consecutive years between 1948 and 1952. In his 2 years as captain the club only lost 1 game.

Open Competitions at Andover.

It is not known when Andover started the Open Singles Tournaments as there are no records before 1934. However after winning the Andover Competition for 3 consecutive years between 1934 and 1936, the **Mayor of Salisbury, Cllr E J Case**, presented a **Challenge Cup** but again we have no records of the winners of this cup before 1950. By the mid seventies interest in this competition had dwindled and it was superseded in 1980 to become a mixed triples competition for a new cup. The original cup was taken by a club member for safe keeping but he then left the club without returning it. However the cup was returned to Andover 27 years later in 2007 when it was found to have been left in a solicitor's vault. Andover bowlers won this competition on 14 of the 28 years that it was held. In **1971 Derek Spencer** donated a trophy for the **Open Pairs Tournament** which was played for between 1971 and 2001 when it was discontinued presumably due to lack of entries. History of Winners and Clubs in **Appendix X**

In **1971** also the **Ladies Open Competition** was introduced playing for the **Josie Finch Cup**. This competition was only won once by an Andover Bowler, **Masie Spinks** in **1983**. History of Winners and Clubs in **Appendix W1**

In **1980 the Mixed Triples** was played for a trophy donated by **Lloyds Bank**. This started as 1 lady and 2 gents but later changed to any mixed triple. Unfortunately in 1999 a team from Banister Park turned up with 3 males and were allowed entry. They subsequently won the competition much to the annoyance of the other teams and after that time the competition was discontinued. History of Winners and Clubs in **Appendix Y**

In **1988 the Ladies Open Pairs Competition** was introduced the trophy being donated by **Masie Spinks and Chris Spencer**.

External Competitions

*Over the life of the club members have had success in external open competitions, county and national championships and district competitions. There are no formal complete records of these events but those that are known about are listed in **Appendix CC**.*

Team Achievements

Salisbury and District League

Andover was a founder member of this league in 1925 along with Shaftesbury and Salisbury and won the league 16 times between then and 1982. Andover have achieved just 4 runners up positions since then but were very unlucky not to win the competition in 2011 when they missed out by 1 point.

Andover have had some success recently in the Salisbury and District League Cup (the Herbie Turner Trophy) winning the trophy in both 2010 and 2011.

*The trophy was donated by the family of Herbie Turner who died in 1981 whilst playing in a Salisbury Association via Wilts presidents match at Alderbury. Originally it was contested by the five clubs he was closely connected with but after difficulty in arranging the competition, it became a Salisbury and District competition in 1989 after not being contested the previous year. It has since prospered and is now keenly competed for each year. **For details refer to Appendix BB***

Whitchurch and District League

*Andover was a founder member of the Whitchurch and District League which was formed in 1934. Originally it was only open to teams within a 12 mile radius of the Whitchurch Town Hall Clock, but more recently it has been extended to include teams from Basingstoke, Hook, Alton and Winchester. Andover won the first division title 7 times between 1953 and 1962 but nothing since. In 1961 they won all their matches to set what was at the time a league record. **For details refer to Appendix BB***

Basingstoke and District League

Andover won the Hants and Berks Cup in 2011

Other records

*Over the clubs long history members have held office at club, county and district level, earned their county blazer badges, been made life honorary members etc and these are recorded in **Appendix AA1 and AA2**.*
